### Beautification Updates:



**Gordon Burkette**

In March, the CID partnered with Gordon Burkette, director of DeKalb County's Keep DeKalb Beautiful initiative and his team to remove **1,000 tires along Lancaster and Old McDonough Roads**. Up to 800 tires will be removed this week, and we'll keep working until the area is free of dumped tires!

The CID also worked closely with DeKalb County, which will be mobilizing crews this month, to begin a cleanup of Moreland Avenue, including mowing and litter pickup. The CID will take this work over in May with help from Russell Landscaping, LLC.

A complete infrastructure inventory report is being prepared that will identify any locations within the right of way in the district boundaries that require improvements including potholes, need for striping, resurfacing, radius upgrades, sign replacements, drainage improvements, etc. [Click here to read the report.](#)

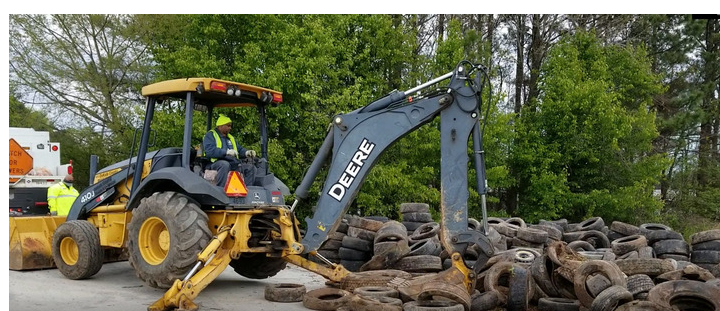

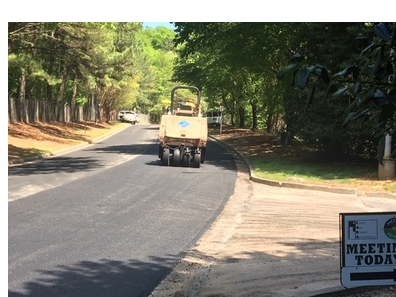

### Transportation Updates:

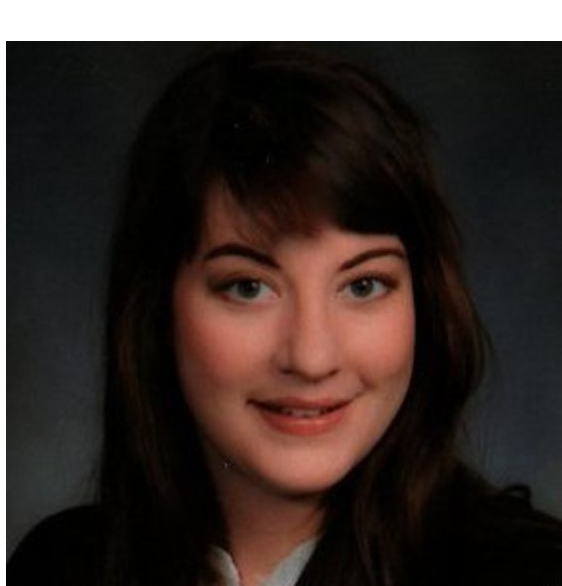
This month, the CID completed resurfacing on Continental Way from Bouldercrest Rd. to International Park Drive. Continental Way is 3,300 ft. in length and International is 1,100 ft.

This effort, which will cost between \$300,000 to \$500,000 to complete, was a part of the CID's request to DeKalb County in 2017 for SPLOST funding to resurface Continental Way, Henrico Road and International Park Drive. The contractor will be resurfacing International Park Drive and Henrico Road sometime this month.

### Virginia Montgomery



Metro South CID Board of Directors would like to introduce its newest board member Virginia Montgomery.

Virginia oversees two companies within the CID, Secured Parking and Thurman Road, but most of her time is spent on Secured Parking, where she's responsible for managing legal work and overseeing the company's development projects.
